Author Guidelines

- 1. The article must be original and must not have been previously published or currently under consideration for publication elsewhere.
- 2. The article should be written in English, with a maximum length of 5,000-8,000 words (excluding the title, abstract, and references).
- 3. The manuscript should be formatted using Times New Roman, font size 12 pt, with 1 line spacing.
- 4. The title should be written in Times New Roman, font size 12 pt, 1 line spacing, and no more than 15 words.
- 5. The article must include abstracts in English, consisting of 100-250 words, written in Times New Roman 12 pt, with 1 line spacing.
- 6. Include 3–5 keywords below each abstract in English.
- 7. All in-text citations and references must follow the APA (American Psychological Association 7th edition) citation style.
- 8. All sources cited in the article must be listed in the references section at the end of the article, in alphabetical order by the last name of the first author and formatted according to APA style.
- 9. The article must be submitted via the submission link in .doc or .rtf format.
